

DATA/District 2 AT Student Scholarship Application

Section 1: Introduction

The DATA/District 2 offers three \$2,000 annual scholarships to current members of the DATA that are enrolled in an Entry-level AT program. These scholarships include:

- *NATA District 2 Athletic Training Student Scholarship*- An award given to an undergraduate student that is a DATA member and enrolled in a CAATE accredited AT program that embodies academic, leadership, and service to the community and/or profession.

- *DATA Student Leadership Award*- An award given to an undergraduate student that is a DATA member and enrolled in a CAATE accredited AT program that embodies leadership amongst their fellow athletic training students and towards the future of the AT profession.

- *DATA Ethnic Diversity Advisory Committee Scholarship*- An award and scholarship given to an ethnically diverse DATA student member enrolled in a CAATE accredited AT program that displays leadership in promoting and a vision towards ethnic diversity within the Athletic Training profession.

The DATA Executive board will screen the candidates and announce at the annual DATA 5k Fundraiser on April 22, 2018.

Section 2: Requirements/Criteria

In order to be eligible for consideration, the applicant shall:

- Demonstrate the qualities and attributes associated with each award and have a minimum GPA of 2.8.
- Be a student member of the DATA and NATA (District 2) at the time of application.
- Be sure the address listed on your NATA membership is a Delaware address
- Be currently enrolled in a CAATE accredited college or university
- Be in their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd year of their active clinical experience at their academic institution. (Observation years will not be considered)
- Intend to pursue Athletic Training as a profession and working towards eligibility to take the NATA certification exam
- Complete and submit the following application including a list of 2 references to:
